PRE-RETIREMENT DEATH GRATUITY
AND
POST RETIREMENT DEATH GRATUITY

What are the Seychelles Pension Fund's pre-retirement and post retirement death gratuities?

The gratuities are paid to the deceased's nominated beneficiary or dependant. There are two types of benefits

- The pre-retirement death benefit is a one time lump sum payment
- The post retirement death gratuity is a one off payment following the death of the pensioner

Who is eligible for a Pre Retirement death gratuity?

The nominated beneficiary or dependent of the deceased's member

Post Retirement

The spouse or dependant of the deceased member

How much is the death gratuity ?

The pre retirement death gratuity is the total mandatory and voluntary contributions in the Fund including interest standing to the credit of the member at the time of death.

The post retirement death gratuity is the equivalent of one month's pension of the deceased member.

If you are the beneficiary when should you apply ?

You should apply as soon as possible after the member's death.

How and Who should complete the application ?

As the beneficiary you are responsible for applying for the benefit.

If you are physically incapable of applying, you may authorize in writing a representative to apply for you.

You should apply for the benefit by completing the prescribed application form supported by

- ⇒ Death Certificate of Member or Certified copy
- ⇒ National Identity Card of claimant
- ⇒ A declaration or affidavit if claimant is not the nominated Beneficiary.

When will payment be made ?

After the application form has been duly completed with supporting documents and submitted. Your application will be processed within a short period of time Payment will be made by cheque or direct deposit into your bank account.

What additional information you may need to know ?

You should nominate the beneficiary by filling the prescribed nomination form obtainable at the Seychelles Pension Fund. This will facilitate the processing of your claim and payment.
